The new and improved castor in the Light equipment castor series

Manner has developed a new PTE wheel with thermoelastic rubber tread and polypropylene centre, which replaces the NK wheels with solid rubber tread. The dark grey thermoelastic rubber tread gives the product line a fresh look and a more competitive price. This change also applies to conductive wheels. The wheels no longer come with plastic bushings and large thread guards.



Tango equipment castor with hand brake

The Tango castor with hand brake has been designed for walking tables and aids and other mobility devices whose users need to control braking and locking the wheels manually.

Stylish and easy-to-install mounting solution. The mounting piece of the tube can be tailored to individual customer needs. The hand brake feature is available for all swivel castor models with or without brake.

The Tango castor with hand brake will go on sale in late 2014 and will be available in a 125 mm wheel diameter, in grey (RAL 7042) and black.

Two-stage brake for Tango castors

This two-stage brake combines directional locking and total-stop brake as separate functions. The brake pedals have two positions. Pressing the brake pedal halfway down locks the swivel in the running position while pressing the pedal all the way down locks also the wheel. A two-stage brake is ideal for devices that need both directional lock and total-stop brake depending on the situation.

First available for 125 mm diameter Tango castors in late 2014.

Special wheel is one of Manner's most important product groups. With nearly a century's experience from designing and manufacturing castor products, Manner has the expertise to manufacture high-quality bespoke wheels and castors for demanding conditions. Since early 1990s Manner has been manufacturing the bespoke wheels used in Erikkila Oy's derrick cars.

The wheels used for light crane systems are strictly regulated in terms of their exact dimensions, shape and bearing capacity. These properties allow the derrick car to run smoothly and extend the lifespan of the crane system. Erikkila cranes are unique because of their low noise level, which creates special requirements for the properties of the wheels. According to Erikkila's managing director Mikko Erikkilä (shown in the picture on the cover), the long-term cooperation between Manner and Erikkila is based on the high quality of the Manner products as well as Manner's strong R&D department and the fact that the companies are both based in Finland. Erikkila uses Manner castor wheels in their Prosystem light crane systems. In the picture on the right, Erikkila's technical director Petteri Lempiäinen demonstrates the aluminium Prosystem light crane system launched at the CeMAT 2014 trade fair. The crane is used for example in vehicle assembly plants all over Europe. Its lifespan is roughly 20 years and 4500 kilometres.

Erikkila Oy is a family-owned Finnish company founded in 1912. It is specialised in the design and manufacturing of ergonomic light crane systems and lifting devices as well as bridge cranes and robotic cranes. Erikkila's primary market area is Europe where over 60 % of its production is exported.
