The Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive came into force across European Union Member States on 1/7/06. RoHS 3 took effect July 22, 2019 and added four restricted substances.

The theory behind the implementation was that the Directive would compliment the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE).
